Reviewing word classes and improving sentences. Using adverbs and fronted adverbials to add more detail. Using 'bossy' language to create an advert. Using taught strategies to answer questions on fiction and non-fiction texts, including poems. Continuing to follow Talk for Writing booklet, culminating in structured story and letter writing. Class reader - 'White Dolphin'.

Handwriting

Common cursive letter patterns and joins. Monitoring pencil grip and correct pressure and posture.

Accurate, neat dictations and copying.

Spelling

The /s/ sound spelt using 'sc', the soft /c/ sound spelt using 'ce' and 'ci', linking the meanings of words within word families

PSHE

Morning class time for conversations and opportunities to share.

Choice of 'helping hand' jobs and 'spreading happiness' activities to do at home each day.

Weekly 15-minute one-to-one sessions to monitor well-being and to go through classwork to monitor progress.

Teeth - quick recap. 7 food groups and why we need them. Digestion and the processes of each organ. Herbivores, carnivores and omnivores, predators, prey and food chains. Amazing animal teeth project and presentation.


Maths
