Information writing and explanation texts

To organise ideas around a theme and group related paragraphs. Secure use of linking ideas within and across paragraphs. To use a variety of text layouts appropriate to purpose. Continue to use a range of techniques to involve the reader. To build in literary features to create an effect e.g. alliteration, onomatopoeia, similes, metaphors, etc.

Handwriting

Practising consistency in forming and joining letters. Continue to develop fluency and increase speed of cursive handwriting, reflecting the level of automaticity.

Spelling

We will focus on the words containing the strings /ough/ and /ear/.

PSHE

To develop protective skills and attributes to keep us and others safe, and decrease their susceptibility to extremist narratives. We will focus on understanding the factors that lead to extremism such as discrimination and intolerance. We will focus on attributes such as resilience, empathy and respect to others.

Science Earth and Space

To understand the basic concepts of the solar system, to grasp the modelling concept (using scales and ratios) and to see different views and opinions with justification.

To create a model of the solar system using

playdough.
To understand shadows, the Earth's rotation, linking to day and night, the

Earth's axis and tilt, to see why we have seasons.

To grasp time zones around the world. To see why the moon changes shape and to learn its phases.

To research facts on the Solar System independently.
