Biology:

Chemistry:

Rates of reaction - measuring rates of reaction: volumes of gas given off and measuring mass of gas, graphs and rates of reaction, gradients, effect of surface area, collision theory in detail and explaining the effects of surface area using collision theory, effect of concentration and explaining the effect of concentration, gas reactions.

Physics:

Levers and uses in the world, simple machines, calculating moments in balancing. Centre of mass and stability, revision questions. Intro to Energy: an introduction into energy transfer through conduction, convection and radiation

Maths

Algebraic Techniques:

Solving equations and inequalities. Generating sequences and finding general terms for sequences. Using algebraic notation for indices and completing problems involving this notation. Substituting values into expressions, rearrange and simplify expressions and solving equations involving indices.
